Oregon's finest pinot noir. One exclusive collection.

<p>Alexana Estate Vineyard and Winery: 2015 Revana Vineyard Estate Pinot Noir</p>	<p>With ten clones, eighteen soils, 25 blocks, nine row orientations and elevation from 360 to 640 this Might be the most complex wine in the Willamette Valley. Eleven months in 35% New French Oak-35% Once Filled and 30% Neutral; built to be enjoyable within a year of bottling (Sept 2016) or with proper storing could be enjoyed at least thru 2021. This wine possesses aromatics of cherry, cola, spicebox, vanilla and fig. In the mouth this will be silky, smooth, vibrant and creamy.</p>
<p>Anderson Family Vineyard: 2015 Dundee Hills Estate Pinot noir</p>	<p>The 2015 vintage was warm and ripe but produced a surprisingly elegant Pinot noir. Intense aromatics of Asian Five Spice and marine air. Initial palate red fruited - raspberry/cranberry - leads to deeper layers of briary sous bois/forest floor. Long and layered. Will age for additional complexity. Native ferment. All gravity/never pumped. Unfiltered. Unfiltered.</p>
<p>Archery Summit: 2015 Arcus Vineyard Pinot Noir</p>	<p>Opulent fruit notes of raspberry coulis, wild strawberry and fresh red cherry arise from the glass of this vintage of the Arcus Estate Pinot Noir, blending with a background of savory nori and cocoa powder. The palate offers generous flavors of concentrated raspberry, Oregon blackcap and blackberry, leading into notes of spice box and lavender incense. A viscous texture creates lasting impressions of ripe black fruit that melt gracefully into the dark chocolate finish.</p>
<p>Argyle Winery: 2015 Cowhouse Pinot Noir</p>	<p>Named after Argyle's founding viticulturist, Allen Holstein, Cowhouse Pinot Noir comes from his personal high elevation vineyard in the Dundee Hills. As Allen would have it no other way, Cowhouse Pinot Noir exhibits classical Dundee Hills silky texture and fine-tuned tannins, complementing the dark cherry, rose petal, and black peppercorn aromatics. After fermentation and gentle pressing, the wine was allowed to age elegantly on its lees for 16 months in French oak, of which 40% were new.</p>
<p>Ayoub Wines: 2015 Ayoub Pinot Noir, Estate vineyard</p>	<p>Perfumy and seductive nose with crushed red berries, dried rose petals, candied orange peel, nutmeg and freshly tiled earth. Satiny and complex on the palate, with generous medley of red fruit, candied orange peel, dark cocoa and spice flavors. The layered finish evolves endlessly on the palate. This is a beautiful wine yet powerful wine, "Iron fist in the velvet glove". Best from 2018 to 2028.</p>
<p>Bella Vida: 2015 Bella Vida O'Donnell Pinot Noir</p>	<p>Brian O'Donnell ^{SEP}starts with 16 barrels of wine from our estate fruit to create a complex 6-barrel three Dijon clone blend yielding 150 cases. Aromatic notes express hints of baking spice, strawberry and raspberry including a pleasing floral component. A round, full layered palate of red cherry, cola and hints of spice lend to a textural complexity that drifts to a finish that has length and fullness.</p>
<p>Cramoisi Vineyard: 2015 Cramoisi Pinot Noir Reserve</p>	<p>This selection of the Vineyards finest barrels, shows off the complexity of both rocky and deep soil, denotes the most sophisticated, elegant and intense wine. Rich and full on the palate, with notes of candied cranberry, cherry and dates with a multitude of aromas including fresh pine needles, hints of smoke, spice and tangerine peel.</p>
<p>De Ponte Cellars: 2015 Baldwin Family Reserve</p>	<p>Nose of French vanilla, mocha and toffee mingles with notes of blackberry and plum. A luscious, concentrated body yields bright acidity and flavors of baking spice and peppercorn. The finish is supported by big, smooth tannins and a persistent finish. Drink thru 2028.</p>
<p>Dobbles Family Estate: 2015 Dundee Hills Cuvée Pinot Noir</p>	<p>A blend of Meyer and Vista Hills vineyards, this cuvée is 22% whole cluster fermentation and 22% new French oak. A variety of aromas leap from the glass representing ripe, red fruits of strawberry preserves, cherry and</p>

	floral pomegranate. Darjeeling tea, cocoa, cedar and mushrooms contribute spice and savory notes. The palate is full-bodied with acid and tannin to balance and carry a long finish. Fermentations using whole cluster contribute bright fruit, savory spice and tannin simultaneously and result in wonderful opportunities for food pairing. Keep this in mind for Thanksgiving and other meals with poultry and fruit accented dishes.
Domaine Drouhin: 2015 Domaine Drouhin Oregon Pinot Noir Laurène	The 2015 Cuvée Laurène is intensely aromatic and complex on the nose. Aromas include dried flowers, violet, spices, blueberry and touch of orange blossom. The palate is captivating, displaying great concentration, with refined texture. It is beautifully balanced, with a long aftertaste. Will age very well over the next 15 years.
Domaine Roy: 2015 Maison Roy & Fils Dundee Hills Incline	The Dundee Hills Incline represents a barrel selection of the "crème de la crème" of the 2015 vintage. Aromatically this wine shows bright pomegranate, red cherry, rose and iron. The palate is generous and full, showing ripe red fruit and silky tannins. The wine has ample concentration and bright acidity, which will allow ageing for 10+ years.
Domaine Serene: 2015 Evenstad Reserve Pinot Noir	Hand selected from their best barrels each year to create a reserve wine that is consistent in both its superior quality, and flavor profile. Never shy in the glass, the 2015 Evenstad Reserve radiates a blissful bouquet of boysenberry, marionberry, dark chocolate, and sage. In the mouth, its graceful texture enters with power and seduces every part of your palate - exposing wave upon wave of alluring flavors of dark fruits, mushroom, and cola. Its silky-smooth, velvet-like tannins give way to a long, weighted finish that endures with unrivaled finesse and persistence.
Durant Vineyards: 2015 Bishop Pinot Noir	A light nose of dried cranberry and Bing cherry is accompanied by a front palate of bold tannin, notes of spice, plum and earth. Leather tones, along with vanilla, clove and dark cherry, thoughtfully present mid-palate and linger into a round finish, on this age worthy Pinot Noir.
Élevée Winegrowers: 2015 Élevée Vineyard Pinot Noir	A Single-Vineyard bottling from our own Dundee Hills Estate. The Jory soils, south aspect, 540ft elevation, and extremely dense planting, deliver this elegantly composed wine, displaying raspberries, fading violet petals, and silk.
Erath Winery: 2015 Knight's Gambit Pinot Noir	The Erath 2015 Knight's Gambit Pinot Noir starts with the rich, red Jory soil of the Dundee Hills and conjures red fruit aromas like red currant, loganberry and red plum that leap from the glass. Aged for 15 months in 100% French oak, this intensely fruit forward wine offers overflowing flavors of raspberry, marionberry and rhubarb. Keen acidity allows for an everlasting finish.
Furioso Vineyards: 2015 La Linea Furioso Pinot Noir	La Linea Furioso Pinot Noir 2015 has an inviting translucent ruby color. Complex aromatically, the wine offers a vibrant bouquet of blood orange, nutmeg, and cranberry, with underlying notes of cinnamon and rose petal. On the palate, these aromas are complemented by flavors of strawberry and an ephemeral hint of licorice. Although young, this wine has delicate tannins and a high level of structural refinement. This elegantly finesse-driven wine will continue to improve in your cellar for the next 6 to 8 years.
Knudsen Vineyards: 2015 Dundee Hills Pinot Noir	Brilliant ruby red color in the glass. A very friendly wine with aromas of ripe red cherry, cranberry, rose, sandalwood, and a touch of earth. Medium weight and concentration wrapped around a core of red fruits with cherry as the centerpiece. Additional accents include baking spices and brioche. Elegantly styled and forward drinking with supple tannins and a robust finish that builds richness over time in the glass.
Lange Estate Winery and Vineyards: 2015 Lange Estate Vineyards Pinot Noir	Featuring entirely Dundee Hills fruit, this bottling displays the earthy minerality of the volcanic soils this AVA is known for. Deep aromas of raspberries and dark cherries are laced with notes of blueberry and soft

	vanilla oak. Intriguing hints of baking spices, earth and minerality are backed with an elegant structure and balanced tannins.
Native Flora: 2015 Pressed for Time Pinot Noir	The 2015 Pressed for Time is a cosmopolitan blend of all the Native Flora producing blocks. Along with great complexity, it offers bright acids, fine ample tannins, and rich, but not overt, fruit on the palate. On the nose you will find an interesting aromatic of cherry wood ash, pau d'arco, vanillin, and spiced, baked cherry pie. Harmoniously balanced from start to finish.
Nysa Vineyard: 2015 Nysa Pinot Noir	Dark red cherry nose and pie spice flavors develop into a lush velvety palate with balanced acidity extending into a long finish of red fruit tones with vanilla accents.
Purple Hands: 2015 Latchkey Vineyard Pinot Noir	A vintage full of beautiful weather and wonderful warm nights, brought a second consecutive spectacular growing season to Oregon. 2015 was one of the largest fruit yielding vintages on record, tied with 2009. The perfect weather during bloom and flower set the vines to dense berry and cluster size. Tasting notes: black candied spice, cardamom, red cherry, barnyard sweat, white chocolate raspberry, savory, and a focused dense finish.
Roco Winery: 2015 Knudsen Vineyards Pinot Noir	Nose filled with black cherry and Klamath plum compote, hints of ginger, saffras and green peppercorn. Plush, mouth-filling fresh blueberry and blueberry preserves on the mid-palate. Wet stone and earthiness with a lengthy finish and seamless textual quality throughout this wine. <i>Winemaker, Rollin Soles</i>
Sokol Blosser: 2015 Old Vineyard Block Pinot Noir	Our 2015 Old Vineyard Block Pinot Noir exhibits warm winter spices and tart cherry on the nose, with Bing Cherry and black currant on the finish.
Torii Mor Vineyard and Winery: 2015 Olson Estate Vineyard Pinot Noir	The 2015 Olson Vineyard aroma is complex, fruity with sweet and inviting with blueberry, dark cherry notes, mixed with red berry highlights over a light earthy background. The flavors are bright, juicy and very forward with red and dark berry notes, chocolate and rich complexity. The bright acidity carries the fruity flavors into the long aftertaste. The texture is round, soft, vibrant and juicy. The finish is very long, bright, a mix of red and dark fruits and earth complexity. This wine can be enjoyed now.
White Rose Estate: 2015 White Rose Vineyard Pinot Noir	Limpid red. Sexy, highly fragrant aromas of red fruit liqueur, Asian spices, incense and minerals, plus cola and floral pastille nuances. Palate-staining yet lithe, alluringly sweet raspberry, cherry pie and floral pastille flavors are energized by blood orange and smoky mineral flourishes. Fine-grained tannins lend shape and gentle grip to the impressively pure and focused finish, which displays excellent clarity and insistent cinnamon and floral pastille qualities.
Winderlea Vineyard & Winery: 2015 Winderlea Vineyard Pinot Noir	Our flagship Pinot noir contains fruit sourced from throughout our estate and showcases the hallmarks of the Winderlea Vineyard. The nose opens with rich aromas of dark cherry and black tea swirling with lilac, plumeria and a hint of cracked pepper. The palate leads with darker notes of coca and fresh roasted coffee lifted up by orange spice and blackberry. Soft tannins and punctuated acidity leads to a lush finish dominated by high toned fruits and a hint of toasted pecan. (Certified Demeter Biodynamic®)
Winters Hill Vineyard: 2015 Pinot Noir Block 10	Block 10 is the highest elevation block planted to Pinot Noir and receives the most direct sunlight. 100% de-stemmed. Moderate garnet color in the glass. Heady aromas of marionberry, purple grape and baking spices. Aims to please in the mouth, with an attack of vivid black cherry and spice flavors that demands attention. Remarkable intensity, yet cohesive tannins and acidity make for seamless drinking.
