Alexana Estate Vineyard & Winery

Alexana Winery was born out of vintner Dr. Madaiah Revana's love of the great wines of Burgundy. After an extensive search for the ideal region and land, Dr. Revana acquired an 80-acre estate uniquely located on the northwestern edge of the Dundee Hills AVA where iron-rich volcanic soils converge with the ancient marine sedimentary soils of the Pacific Ocean.

2018 Revana Vineyard Estate Pinot Noir: Offering dynamic raspberry and blueberry flavors that gather notes of spiced cinnamon and orange oil, building toward medium-grained tannins.



Anderson Family Vineyard

This vineyard has been our family's mission since we found our 20-acres – an ancient pile of fractured basalt – in the Dundee Hills in 1989. And since, through years of clearing and planting, supply of superior wine grapes to several winery partners, and creation of our own hands-on small-batch bottlings, our goals have remained the same: plant on steep slopes, grow deep roots, deliver intense flavors. Enjoy!

2018 Dundee Hills Estate Pinot Noir: Bold, complex, layered and long. A dark, boysenberry driven wine with aromatics of marine air and petrichor. A bigger Pinot from our steep, rock-slide site.



Archery Summit Winery

Since its start in 1993, Archery Summit has long been committed to understanding the intricacies and unique characteristics of each of our vineyards, resulting in wines that vividly express their distinct places of origin.

2018 Arcus Vineyard Pinot Noir: With strawberry rhubarb driving the nose and a palate made of raspberry and currant, the 2018 Arcus Pinot Noir is tied tightly to the red end of the fruit spectrum. This wine explores every corner of our cellar, having been fermented in stainless steel, concrete, and wood. As a result, the Pinot Noir is dynamic, with a ceaseless and infectious energy that can be felt with every taste. A persistent finish reminds of the intriguing depth of the 2018 growing season.



Argyle Winery

A pioneer in the Oregon wine industry, Argyle was founded in 1987 by Rollin Soles to capture the unique terroir of the Willamette Valley in a sparkling wine. Now Argyle produces one of the most diverse portfolios in Oregon – Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Riesling and Sparkling wines.

2018 Spirithouse Pinot Noir: Entirely from Knudsen Vineyard, Spirithouse Pinot Noir displays the delicacy and refinement of the Dundee Hills, while exhibiting the depth and texture of the 2018 vintage. Red cherry, black tea, and savory spice open into delicate floral complexity. The silky tannins and generous weight are balanced with crisp, high elevation acidity, providing tension to the long finish. After fermentation and free run draining, the wine was allowed to age elegantly on its lees for 16 months in French oak, of which 30% were new.



Arterberry Maresh

Maresh Vineyard produces some of the most sought after and acclaimed fruit in Oregon. Planted predominately to Pommard and Wadenswil clones, the vineyard contains some of the oldest vine Pinot in the state. It is the 5th oldest vineyard in the state and the oldest on Worden Hill Road. Winemaker Jim Maresh is the third generation of the Maresh family working on the farm.

2018 Maresh Vineyard Pinot Noir: The 2018 Pinot Noir Maresh Vineyard is an incredible wine. It opens slowly to an arresting perfume of dusty earth, dried rose petals, tea leaves, licorice and amaro with a wealth of bright red berry fruit at the core. The palate is elegant, supple and juicy, with an expansive fan of layered, spicy flavors and a very long finish. It's hard to resist now, but it will have more to offer with time in bottle.



Bella Vida Vineyard

Steven Whiteside was drawn to Oregon in 1992 by a friendship with Jim and Loie Maresh. Nestled in the Dundee Hills, Bella Vida Vineyard, is comprised of 26 sustainably farmed acres of mostly Pinot Noir and a touch of Chardonnay. The wines are crafted by 4 exceptionally talented winemakers who have learned the nuances of the site over the past 20 vintages. Enjoy the expression of the site, their knowledge and their talent. Cheers!

2018 Bella Vida O'Donnell Pinot Noir: Lush silky texture contributes finesse in this complex Pinot Noir. Ripe, deep, black cherry fruit flavors with notes of spice and rose are deftly balanced with toasty oak offering a long, lingering finish. The 2018 vintage provides both an early approachability matched with great cellaring potential. Drink now through 2028. 168 cases produced.

Cramoisi Vineyards

Cramoisi, French for crimson, is derived from the delightful crimson clover that blankets the vineyard every spring. Vibrant, elegant, earthy; Cramoisi reflects the color, beauty and complexity of our boutique wines born from red volcanic soils. Organic, Biodynamic farm, Estate grown with respect for the land, the grape and hardworking vineyard stewards. Every bottle honors and delivers our passion, from soil to glass.

2018 Cramoisi Vineyard Reserve Pinot Noir: This selection of the vineyard's finest barrels, shows off the complexity of both rocky and deep soils, denotes the most sophisticated, elegant, and intense wine. The best representation of the best four barrels. Medium and low toast. 2018 expresses a very dry season, elevating the tannins with a smooth feeling in the palate, rich body, earthy truffle notes, plums and hint of pine needles.



Dobbes Family Estate

Founded in 2002, Dobbes Family Estate embodies over three decades of fine winemaking. We make wines that are true to their varietal character, showing as much depth, elegance, opulence and balance as possible. Dobbes is dedicated to consistently crafting wines that exude the best of Oregon including traditionally made Burgundian-inspired Pinot Noir and other varietals from Oregon's Willamette and Rogue Valleys.

2018 Dundee Hills Cuvée Pinot Noir: This wine is a perfect snapshot of the classic characteristics of the Dundee Hills: red fruits, spice, and earth. Multi-layered cherry aromas from pie to preserves dominate against a gentle backdrop of blueberry, raspberry, subtle oak spice and vanilla. The palate carries the red fruit theme with a tart expression of currant and cranberry, accented with cola and plum. A vibrant mouthfeel from youthful tannins and mouthwatering acid carries the medium long finish.



Domaine Drouhin Oregon

Established in 1987, Domaine Drouhin Oregon is owned by the Drouhin Family of Burgundy. Fourth-generation winemaker Véronique Boss-Drouhin produces wines of distinction, balance, elegance, and longevity. Philippe Drouhin, who oversees the family vineyards in Burgundy and Oregon, is responsible for the 225-acre estate.

2018 Domaine Drouhin Oregon Pinot Noir Laurène: In many ways, the 2018 Laurène embodies what we love most about wines from the Dundee Hills. Offering beautiful clarity and a garnet color on approach, the aromatics brim with notes of dried red cherry, spice, wild herbs, earth, and subtle oak. Characteristically elegant, the wine evolves on the palate, moving seamlessly from its pomegranate welcome into its detailed lines of clove, white pepper, and cranberry. As always, cellaring the Laurène over the next 5-15 years will be well rewarded.



Domaine Roy

Domaine Roy & Fils found its home on a site named the Iron Filbert Vineyard, paying homage to the iron rich Jory soil series and the old filbert orchard that once stood there. Planted in April of 2013 with neighboring iconic vineyards of Bergström, Cameron, and Maresh. Ten clones of Pinot Noir and two clones of chardonnay make up a high-density average of 2310 vines per acre.

2018 Domaine Roy & Fils, Incline Pinot Noir: The Dundee Hills Incline from our Iron Filbert Vineyard has flamboyant aromas of nectarine, raspberry, hibiscus and rose. On the palate, it shows a deep intense flavor profile, rounded by silky tannins. Although this wine has lots of flavor concentration, it maintains a remarkable balance. We anticipate it will drink well for 10+ years.

Domaine Serene Winery

Grace and Ken Evenstad first arrived and settled in the Dundee Hills in the Willamette Valley in 1989. At that time, the couple had spent over 20 years together in Minnesota building a successful business, a loving family, and a deep appreciation for the wines of Burgundy. The Evenstads had faith in Oregon early on and invested in a 42-acre hilltop estate that had just been logged in the beautiful Dundee Hills of Oregon.

2018 'Evenstad Reserve' Pinot Noir: A brilliant ruby red color, the 2018 'Evenstad Reserve' Pinot Noir expresses aromas of dried cherry, dark chocolate and saddle leather on the nose. On the palate, ripples of composed tannins and savory characters of cherry tobacco, ground cloves and allspice reveal themselves, leading to a finish of great concentration and acidity. This Pinot Noir is beautiful on release and will age gracefully in the cellar for years to come.



DOMAINE SERENE

Durant Vineyards

First and foremost, the Durant Family strives to be viticulturists whose wines reflect careful farming and craftsmanship. As a founder in the Oregon wine industry, with our first plantings in 1973, our goal is to produce wines that are of the highest quality. Our 100% estate grown fruit is proudly labeled as Durant Vineyards.

2018 Olivia Grace Pinot Noir: The entrance of the 2018 Olivia Grace Pinot Noir is focused on ripe red fruit notes of raspberry and fresh cut strawberries, along with cinnamon, anise, and cracked pepper spices. The mid-palate turns its attention to earth and barrel components while filling all corners with integrated, silky tannins. A zesty, playful acidity keeps all the complex layers bright and fresh while exhibiting a thought provoking and lingering finish.



Élevée Winegrowers

Élevée Winegrowers is a "Study in Terroir" ...focused on exploring the distinct flavors of the Willamette Valley's diverse Appellations. We believe that a wine is shaped equally by one's growing and winemaking choices. In fact, we feel they are one and the same. Consequently, at the heart of Élevée is this concept of 'winegrower'... one part 'winemaker', one part 'grower'. The two are inextricably linked.

2018 Élevée Vineyard Pinot Noir: This wine reveals a captivating perfume of raspberries, cherries, keemun black tea & powdered lilacs, with hints of baking spices & cola, around a mineral core. This is a medium to full body wine, with lively acidity & broad, fine, silky texture. The long finish lingers with a chorus of raspberries, fading violet petals, & Dundee dust.



Erath Winery

Erath wines are an expression of the land that this winery has cultivated for over 50 years. Disciplined in approach, yet progressive in artistry, our winemaker strives to create wines that reflect the prestige of the region and honor the rich history of the brand.

2018 Knights Gambit Pinot Noir: Alluringly dark and dense with aromas of black plum, grilled meat, Mission fig and baking spice offer a seductive prelude. Flavors include dark plum, cherry, black-cap raspberry and English tea. Tannin is lithe and present contributing texture and balancing perfectly with subtle acidity.



Furioso Vineyards

Winemaking is in my family, although on a small scale. What, then, do you hold in your glass? It is the lingering scent of crushed grapes; the vivid memory of my grandfather tasting from each barrel in our home cellar. It is the tendrils of the vine that held my famiglia together as we moved from Italy to Canada, to the United States. It is the magic of fermentation, the transformative process of life as an artist, a businessman, and now, at last, a vineyard owner. It is the gift of family, the extension of the Furioso line, the fruit of a lifetime's experience. "It is my greeting to you, in fellowship and in health. Cent'anni, Giorgio."

2018 La Linea Furioso Pinot Noir: For the 2018 vintage of La Linea we used an equal amount of Pommard and Dijon 115 clones. That year, La Linea, usually more "feminine" in style than L'Altra, showed us more its "tomboy" side, exhibiting aromas of violet and black cherry with hints of coffee bean and cigar box. The wine has plenty of refreshing acid with generous tannins, which will tame with time in the bottle, and lead to a salivating finish.



Holloran Vineyard Wines

As a grower and wine producer since 1999 in Oregon's Willamette Valley, our handcrafted wines begin in the vineyards we own and farm. We emphasize low yields and careful hands-on management of the vines to produce wines that express the unique characteristics of our vineyard sites, including our older vines planted in the early 1970s. We produce Pinot Noir, Tempranillo, Riesling, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc.

2018 Holloran Pinot Noir Le Pavillon Vineyard: The 2018 Holloran Le Pavillon Pinot Noir shows a garnet hue, and the nose of rhubarb and strawberry is highlighted by spicy cinnamon notes. The soft, silky palate texture offers classic Dundee Hills dusty cherry notes. Crisp acid and firm tannins outline an extended finish. Drink 2024-2034. Knudsen Vineyards

Knudsen Vineyards is an iconic vineyard in the heart of the acclaimed Dundee Hills AVA overlooking the fertile Willamette Valley, majestic Mt. Hood and the North Cascade Mountain range. The Knudsen family has grown grapes and made wine for 50 years. Knudsen Vineyards was established in 1971 by Cal and Julia Lee Knudsen. As second-generation stewards of Knudsen Vineyards, Page, Colin, David and Cal Jr embrace their family's legacy and honor their parents by making great wine reflecting the unique attributes of their land.

2018 Dundee Hills Pinot Noir: Deep ruby red hues with rich underlying spice and dark fruit aromatics. Youthful and bold with a textural pallet showing gripping tannins, firm acidity and mouth coating structure. Hints of tangerine peel and chocolate ganache are present while flavors of cola and ginger spice continue to open up as the wine aerates. This is a beautiful contrast from recent vintages, with a savory umami sensation that teases your tastebuds and suggests the potential for long cellaring time. Decant this wine at least 1 hour prior to drinking if you open early. This wine will easily age for 9-11 years in a properly controlled cellar.

Lange Winery

Don and Wendy Lange founded their eponymous winery and estate vineyard in 1987 with the purchase of a thirty-acre parcel in Northern Willamette Valley's prestigious Dundee Hills. Their move north from Santa Barbara was precipitated by a few inspiring bottles from two of Oregon's most iconic producers: Eyrie and Erath. A call to Dick Erath (whose phone number was listed on the back label) convinced the Langes to embark on a scouting trip. Starting at the southern end of the Willamette Valley, they tasted their way up, stopping only when they reached the Dundee Hills. The couple saw a real estate sign advertising a property suitable for farmland—the property's elevation and aspect reminded Don of the Grand Cru vineyards of Burgundy's Côte d'Or. The Langes planted their estate vineyard in 1988.

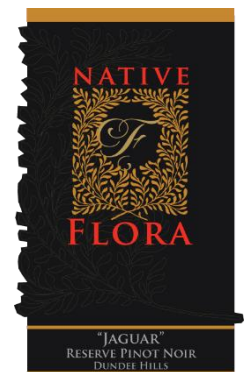
LANGE ESTATE

2018 Lange Estate Vineyards Pinot Noir: The 2018 Lange Estate Pinot Noir expresses layered, deeply perfumed aromas of blueberry, blackberry, savory herbs, violets, and spice cake. Plush, supple tannins frame a juicy black fruit core, followed by a long and seamless finish.

Native Flora

Native Flora, the Dundee Hills Winery Sanctum, is a small, secluded vineyard and winery hidden high above the Chehalem Valley. With stunning vistas, innovative ideas, and a rebel spirit, we produce premium estate wines in limited quantities for folks who enjoy great wine. The earth, the vineyard, the people, the flora and fauna, the buildings, the rain – everything that exists on our 33-acre site – work in harmony to grow great grapes and produce fine wine.

2018 Jaguar Reserve Pinot Noir: Jaguar represents the pinnacle of the Native Flora Pinot production. A clonal selection of 8 barrels, anchored by 828 and Wadenswil, this pinot shows great depth, power and structure. Rose floral aromatics interlaced with dark cherry, lavender and anise delight the nose, while layers of cherry pie, cola and sandalwood fill the mouth.



Résonance

As stewards of our Oregon estate vineyards and winery, the Résonance team shares close, personal relationships going back more than 50 years. When a world-class wine lets us discover the soul of a place, something magical happens. A deeply emotional and physical connection to its land, its people, its culture, and its history. This place, its harmony, fills us.

2018 Découverte Vineyard Pinot Noir: A nice and brilliant color for this wine, with an expressive nose of cherry, blackberries, wild mint, fresh licorice and noble wood. Vibrant and energetic, the palate reveals a subtle balance and elegant floral notes. The finale is mineral driven, expressing the complexity of the Jory soil.

RÉSONANCE

Sokol Blosser

For nearly 50 years, before there was an Oregon wine industry, the Sokol Blosser family began growing grapes in the Dundee Hills of Oregon's Willamette Valley. Situated on a certified organic 89-acre vineyard with another 16 acres of vineyards in Eola-Amity Hills and 22 acres in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA, B Corp certified Sokol Blosser Winery consistently captures the terroir of the region as expressed through the brilliance of its estate fruit. One of the pioneering wineries of Oregon, Sokol Blosser is run by the Sokol Blosser family, who emphasize sustainability and good to the earth policies in every phase of business.

2018 Old Vineyard Block Pinot Noir: This 2018 Old Vineyard Block Pinot Noir exhibits scents of red fruit with hints of leather and allspice. The palate has rich pomegranate, red cherry and more leather.



Winter's Hill Estate

Sitting atop the storied Dundee Hills of Oregon, Winter's Hill is owned and operated by the Gladhart family. Today the third generation is developing the farm established in 1961. Together with our employees, we manage our vineyards, fields, and forests for the long-term benefit of our family and our community. The vineyards were planted in 1990, and we produce 100% estate grown and produced wines from Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris and Pinot Blanc.

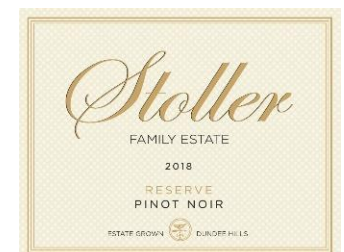
2018 Winters Hill Pinot Noir Block 8: This wine from the Wadensvil clone of Pinot noir has more delicate tannins than some other blocks of the Winters Hill vineyard. The nose highlights the sweet red cherry, savory herbs, and a hint of black tea. The palate is juicy and luscious with a medium body highlighted by savory herbs, black cherry, and a hint of vanilla with soft fine tannins for a smooth finish.



Stoller Family Estate

At Stoller, our roots run deep. The family established the property in 1943 and the vineyard fifty years later. Today, we are the largest contiguous vineyard in Oregon's Dundee Hills. We control every step of the process, from pruning to bottling and everything in between. The result is award-winning wines that are balanced, complex, and consistently exceptional. Much has changed from the original farm, but one thing remains constant: our pioneering spirit. Our winery is the first in the world to receive LEED Gold certification, attesting that our winery is sustainably built and environmentally friendly.

2018 Stoller Family Estate Reserve Pinot Noir: Our Reserve Pinot Noir is a compilation of established sections of our vineyard. These sections were carefully chosen over time because they reflect the maturity of our site. Native yeast fermented in stainless steel tanks and our oak fermenter, it spent 12-months in French oak barrels where it saw full malolactic conversion prior to bottling. Our 2018 Reserve Pinot Noir opens with aromatics of ripe plum, dried bing cherries, baking spice, and earth. The palate is supple, carrying flavors of cola and bing cherry, with hints of cedar and flint. This wine can be enjoyed now; however, it was constructed for longevity with proper cellaring.



White Rose Estate

In the summer of 2000, Greg Sanders knocked on the door of an old farm house sitting at the top of the Dundee Hills in Oregon's Willamette Valley. The house was just up the gravel road from a few of Oregon's most notable wineries: Archery Summit, Domaine Drouhin Oregon and Domaine Serene. Surrounding the farm house was a small vineyard, self-rooted in 1980, that over the years had become known for the quality of its fruit. Having been an impassioned fan of pinot noir for many years, it was Greg's dream to own a vineyard from which he could produce artisanal, hand-made wines of outstanding quality. His search had led him to the top of this hill, and when he left, he took with him the deed to a dream.

2018 Winemakers Cuvée Pinot Noir: The White Rose 2018 Winemaker's Cuvée is 100% whole cluster fermented and basket pressed in White Rose's traditional style. Our goal every year with this blend is to create an object of beauty, a definitive statement of art relating to each unique vintage. In 2018, the blend was entirely sourced from vineyards in the Dundee Hills.
