

Alexana Winery

Alexana Winery was born out of vintner Dr. Madaiah Revana's love of the great wines of Burgundy. After an extensive search for the ideal region and land, Dr. Revana acquired an 80-acre estate uniquely located on the northwestern edge of the Dundee Hills AVA where iron-rich volcanic soils converge with the ancient marine sedimentary soils of the Pacific Ocean.

2019 Revana Vineyard Estate Pinot Noir: Rhubarb, allspice, and wet earth aromas. Black cherry with cinnamon and cocoa on the palate. Rounded mouthfeel, smooth finish and nice acidity make for a long finish.

Anderson Family Vineyard

This vineyard has been our family's mission since we found our 20-acres – an ancient pile of fractured basalt – in the Dundee Hills in 1989. And since, through years of clearing and planting, supply of superior wine grapes to several winery partners, and creation of our own hands-on small-batch bottlings, our goals have remained the same: plant on steep slopes, grow deep roots, deliver intense flavors. Enjoy!

2019 Dundee Hills Estate Pinot Noir: Cooler vintage Pinot noir with light, lifted red fruit. Raspberry, cranberry and cherries. Loaded with signature AFV spice: anise, cinnamon, clove and ginger. Backbone of forest floor. Petrichor and marine aromatics. Elegant and built to age.



Archery Summit Winery

Since its start in 1993, Archery Summit has long been committed to understanding the intricacies and unique characteristics of each of our vineyards, resulting in wines that vividly express their distinct places of origin.

2019 Red Hills Vineyard Pinot Noir: This wine's dark garnet hue matches its deep and rich personality. Fig, cherry and a bit of truffle waft from the glass while the first sip is characterized by cacao, black tea and a dash of rose and jasmine. An outspoken and engaging wine, the Red Hills Pinot Noir steals the room as soon as the cork is popped. Better still, there's added depth thanks to some whole cluster inclusion and a complementary dose of new French oak (34%).

Argyle Winery

A pioneer in the Oregon wine industry, Argyle was founded in 1987 by Rollin Soles to capture the unique terroir of the Willamette Valley in a sparkling wine. Now Argyle produces one of the most diverse portfolios in Oregon – Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Riesling and Sparkling wines.

2019 Cowhouse Pinot Noir: Named after Argyle's founding viticulturist, Allen Holstein, Cowhouse Pinot Noir comes from his salient vineyard in the higher elevations of the Dundee Hills. As Allen would have it no other way, Cowhouse Pinot Noir exhibits classical Dundee Hills refinement and silky texture. Dark cherry, orange blossom, and savory cinnamon are woven with the savory depth and elegant length. After fermentation and gentle pressing, the wine was allowed to age elegantly on its lees for 16 months in French oak, of which 40% were new.



Bella Vida Vineyard

Steven Whiteside was drawn to Oregon in 1992 by a friendship with Jim and Loie Maresh. Nestled in the Dundee Hills, Bella Vida Vineyard, is comprised of 26 sustainably farmed acres of mostly Pinot Noir and a touch of Chardonnay. This is the last vintage produced by Bella Vida as Steve decided to sell his vineyard to the Nicholas Family and it is now called Nicholas Family Vineyard.

2019 Two Row Pinot Noir: Our Two Row Proprietor's Cuvee is a blend of all seven pinot noir clones that were picked and fermented simultaneously, allowing you to taste the entire vineyard in one sip. Varietal, clones, elevations, fruit ripeness, soil profiles, aspect, rootstocks and most of all "mother nature" are expressed.



Cramoisi Vineyards

Cramoisi, French for crimson, is derived from the delightful crimson clover that blankets the vineyard every spring. Vibrant, elegant, earthy; Cramoisi reflects the color, beauty and complexity of our boutique wines born from red volcanic soils. Organic, Biodynamic farm, Estate grown with respect for the land, the grape and hardworking vineyard stewards. Every bottle honors and delivers our passion, from soil to glass.

2019 Cramoisi Vineyard Reserve Pinot Noir: This selection of the vineyards 5 finest barrels, very elegant lighter crimson color, shows off the complexity of both rocky and deep soils, denotes the most sophisticated notes and selection of the best barrels. Delicate fruit forward, toffee, caramel, cranberry notes with beautiful earthy aromas. The great finish, structure and body make this a wine with a very long life ahead. 50% new oak Estate wine, organic and Biodynamic grown grapes, minimum intervention to be able to express the essence of our land and grape.



Dobbes Family Estate

Founded in 2002, Dobbes Family Estate embodies over three decades of fine winemaking. We make wines that are true to their varietal character, showing as much depth, elegance, opulence, and balance as possible. Dobbes is dedicated to consistently crafting wines that exude the best of Oregon including traditionally made Burgundian-inspired Pinot Noir and other varietals from Oregon's Willamette and Rogue Valleys.

2019 Dundee Hills Cuvée Pinot Noir: The Dundee Hills' characteristic red volcanic Jory soil and well-established vines help produce wines that express the subtlety, nuance and vibrancy of Pinot Noir. This multi-vineyard cuvée delivers on this promise - silky red fruits, floral notes, elegant acidity and a hint of earthiness. Pair this classic Willamette Valley gem with pork tenderloin, roast chicken, or goat cheese.



Domaine Drouhin Oregon

Established in 1987, Domaine Drouhin Oregon is owned by the Drouhin Family of Burgundy. Fourth-generation winemaker Véronique Boss-Drouhin produces wines of distinction, balance, elegance, and longevity. Philippe Drouhin, who oversees the family vineyards in Burgundy and Oregon, is responsible for the 235-acre estate.

2019 Domaine Drouhin Oregon Pinot Noir Laurène: In the flush of its youth, the 2019 Laurène sparkles like a bright ruby. Cherry, mulberry, blackcurrant, and spices all harmonize into a beautifully aromatic bouquet. An overall graceful character is balanced by a firm structure and velvety tannins. This Laurène is a shining example of everything we've come to know and cherish from our vineyards in the Dundee Hills.



Domaine Roy & fils

Domaine Roy & Fils found its home on a site named the Iron Filbert Vineyard, paying homage to the iron rich Jory soil series and the old filbert orchard that once stood there. Planted in April of 2013 with neighboring iconic vineyards of Bergström, Cameron, and Maresh. Ten clones of Pinot Noir and two clones of chardonnay make up a high-density average of 2310 vines per acre.

2019 Domaine Roy & Fils, Incline Pinot Noir: Bursting red aromatics – strawberry, rose petal – are tempered by yeasted pain de mie, toasted brown sugar, and ripe stems. This is a far more accessible rendition of our Dundee Hills estate than the Iron Filbert bottling, with silky tannins and a concentration of sweet red fruit that – although not without aging potential –practically begs for consumption in the near term.

Wine description: Aged on lees for 11 months in neutral French Oak barrels. Coopers include Atelier Centre France, Taransaud,

and François Frères. We practice native primary and secondary fermentations, embracing the micro-biome present in our vineyard sites. Produced with 21 days of skin contact, with very minimal extraction to keep the wines elegant.

Domaine Serene Vineyards & Winery

Grace and Ken Evenstad first arrived and settled in the Dundee Hills in the Willamette Valley in 1989. At that time, the couple had spent over 20 years together in Minnesota building a successful business, a loving family, and a deep appreciation for the wines of Burgundy. The Evenstads had faith in Oregon early on and invested in a 42-acre hilltop estate that had just been logged in the beautiful Dundee Hills of Oregon.

2019 'Evenstad Reserve' Pinot Noir: A brilliant ruby red color, the 2019 'Evenstad Reserve' Pinot Noir expresses aromas of dark dried cherries, pink peppercorn, and saddle leather on the nose. On the palate, layers of composed tannins and savory characters of cherrywood, ground sage and dried shiitake mushrooms reveal themselves, leading to an acidic finish that lingers with soft and silky tannins. This Pinot Noir is beautiful on release and will age gracefully in the cellar for years to come.



Durant Vineyards

First and foremost, the Durant Family strives to be viticulturists whose wines reflect careful farming and craftsmanship. As a founder in the Oregon wine industry, with our first plantings in 1973, our goal is to produce wines that are of the highest quality. Our 100% estate grown fruit is proudly labeled as Durant Vineyards.

2019 Olivia Grace Pinot Noir: The 2019 Olivia Grace Pinot Noir has rich aromatics of candied cherry and fresh cut strawberries, along with spice notes of nutmeg, clove, and cinnamon. The palate is both silky and bright, boasting complex layers from start to finish.



Dusky Goose

Dusky Goose was founded in 2002 in Dundee – Oregon's premier winegrowing region, by John and Linda Carter. The object from the beginning was to make memorable, age-worthy wines that rival the best examples of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from the Old World.

2019 Dundee Hills Pinot Noir: We have been producing our Dundee Hills Pinot Noir since 2002. Sourced from our Estate Rambouillet Vineyard and our neighboring Lillie's Vineyard, this wine is a true display of the terroir we call home. Classic Dundee Hills nose of spice, black pepper, tobacco, and red fruits leading to red and black cherry, toasty oak, and baking spice flavors on the palate. Elegant and delicate with persistent soft tannins and seamless acidity from beginning to end.

Élevée Winegrowers

Élevée Winegrowers is a "Study in Terroir" ...focused on exploring the distinct flavors of the Willamette Valley's diverse Appellations. Our ultimate goal is to introduce you to the most beautiful, dramatic, and wonderfully diverse personalities of Pinot noir and Riesling from Oregon's Willamette Valley. To achieve this we have identified, and continue to identify, the most dramatic environments to grow our grapes, that promise to deliver wines with the most dramatic expressions. We then carefully farm our vineyards and handle our wines in ways that capture the purest expression of each site.

2019 Élevée Vineyard Pinot Noir: This wine reveals a captivating perfume of raspberries, cherries, keemun black tea, & powdered lilacs, with hints of baking spices & cola, around a mineral core. This is a medium to full body wine, with lively acidity, & broad, fine, silky texture. The long finish lingers with a chorus of raspberries, fading violet petals, & Dundee dust.



OREGON PINOT NOIR

Erath Winery

Erath wines are an expression of the land that this winery has cultivated for over 50 years. Disciplined in approach, yet progressive in artistry, our winemaker strives to create wines that reflect the prestige of the region and honor the rich history of the brand.

2019 Knights Gambit Pinot Noir: Shimmering garnet in the glass, the bright hue matches the aromas of boysenberry, Bing cherry, and ripe fig. The smooth and silky palate is caressed by cherry cordial, mixed berries and tangy pomegranate. The lengthy finish is buoyed by high-tone, food friendly acidity and supple tannin.



Furioso Vineyards

Furioso Vineyards was founded in 2014 by Italian-born artist and developer Giorgio Furioso. Nestled in the heart of the Dundee Hills, the tasting room is a truly unique space – seventy feet long, thirty feet deep, featuring fourteenfoot-high glass walls and offering unobstructed valley views on all four sides. We primarily source from our two estate vineyards: the old-vine Furioso Vineyard in the Dundee Hills, as well as our younger Trovato Vineyard in Yamhill-Carlton. We produce elegant and restrained expressions of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Rosé, Tocai Friulano, and Méthode Champenoise sparkling. We invite you to discover our terroir-driven, estate-grown wines in a one of a kind setting, accompanied by unparalleled hospitality.

2019 La L'Altra Pinot Noir: A true cherry color in glass, the 2019 iteration of our L'Altra is ripe with notes of juicy Italian plums, cranberry sauce, and hints of tangerine. Following its fruity beginnings then, is a more rustic backbone of woodsy cedar and fresh rosemary. While young, the palate shows off a wonderfully pure expression of fruit, though never cloying - its notes of luscious rainier cherries, blueberry, and soft cinnamon are livened by a powerful acidity and evolving yet vibrant finish. We recommend drinking now through 2030.

Knudsen Vineyards

Knudsen Vineyards is an iconic vineyard in the heart of the acclaimed Dundee Hills AVA overlooking the fertile Willamette Valley, majestic Mt. Hood and the North Cascade Mountain range. The Knudsen family has grown grapes and made wine for 50 years. Knudsen Vineyards was established in 1971 by Cal and Julia Lee Knudsen. As second-generation stewards of Knudsen Vineyards, Page, Colin, David and Cal Jr embrace their family's legacy and honor their parents by making great wine reflecting the unique attributes of their land.

2019 Knudsen Vineyards Family Series Pinot Noir: A regal Pinot with stunning elegance! Aromas of orange peel and cherry cola are perfectly balanced with red berry and baking spice flavors that grip the palate with delicate acidity and medium tannins. An Oregon classic!



Lange Estate

Don and Wendy Lange founded their eponymous winery and estate vineyard in 1987 with the purchase of a thirty-acre parcel in Northern Willamette Valley's prestigious Dundee Hills. Their move north from Santa Barbara was precipitated by a few inspiring bottles from two of Oregon's most iconic producers: Eyrie and Erath. A call to Dick Erath (whose phone number was listed on the back label) convinced the Langes to embark on a scouting trip.


Starting at the southern end of the Willamette Valley, they tasted their way up, stopping only when they reached the Dundee Hills. The couple saw a real estate sign advertising a property suitable for farmland—the property's elevation and aspect reminded Don of the Grand Cru vineyards of Burgundy's Côte d'Or. The Langes planted their estate vineyard in 1988.



2019 Lange Estate Vineyards Pinot Noir: Opens with a deeply perfumed nose of blueberry crumble, Rainier Cherry, Christmas Cake, dark chocolate, and violet that builds in the glass. A study in precision and elegance, the 2019 Lange Estate Vineyard Pinot Noir boasts black tea-soaked tannins that lend to the perception of overall silkiness as it fans out across the palate before it's hemmed in by mineral flecks and notes of dried orange peel that emerge on the finish.

Meraviglioso Winery

Meraviglioso means wonderous or wonderful in Italian. We are a boutique winery, where we specialize in Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Bubbles, but still have a few other wines on our menu. When visiting you can almost always expect an owner poured tasting. We enjoy sharing our love of live music and art with our guests.





Native Flora

Native Flora, the Dundee Hills Winery Sanctum, is a small, secluded vineyard and winery hidden high above the Chehalem Valley. With stunning vistas, innovative ideas, and a rebel spirit, we produce premium estate wines in limited quantities for folks who appreciate great bottles. The earth, the vineyard, the people, the flora and fauna, the buildings, the rain – everything that exists on our 33-acre site – work in harmony to grow great grapes and produce fine wine.

2019 Jaguar Reserve Pinot Noir: Jaguar represents the pinnacle of the Native Flora Pinot production. A clonal selection of barrels, anchored by 828 and Wadenswil, this pinot shows great depth, power and structure. When we first personified this wine with the name *Jaguar*, it was to describe a dark, stealthy, muscular kitty of a wine. It has become a very apt analogy for describing the wine on a year-to-year basis. The 2019 Jaguar is a bit lighter in build, still powerful but more tawny, less muscular. It is quicker than most of its brethren, faster and more agile among the treetops. This is a sleek, elusive cat. Cellar up to 15+ years.



Nysa Vineyards

Nysa Vineyard is a family-owned operation founded in 1990. Owner and winemaker, Michael Mega purchased a parcel of orchards high in the Dundee Hills of Oregon in anticipation of growing world-class pinot. It was with passion, hard work and patience that Nysa Vineyard has become one of the most prestigious in the hills, providing Pinot noir to acclaimed producers throughout the Willamette Valley.

2019 Estate Pinot Noir: This wine begins with an enticing aroma of cherry and candy apple. The flavors and velvety texture envelope the palate with notes of red cherry and raspberry leading to an extended finish of cardamom and tart apple. Fruit from Nysa Vineyard (Dundee Hills), clones: Pommard, Dijon 115, 777, Coury, Wadenswil, 10 months in 25% new French oak, 13.6% ABV



2019 Découverte Vineyard Pinot Noir: A nice and brilliant color for this wine, with an expressive nose of cherry, blackberries, wild mint, fresh liquorice and noble wood. Vibrant and energetic, the palate reveals a subtle balance and elegant floral notes. The finale is mineral driven, expressing the complexity of the Jory soil. $R \in S \cap A \cap C \in F$

For nearly 50 years, before there was an Oregon wine industry, the Sokol Blosser family began growing grapes in the Dundee Hills of Oregon's Willamette Valley. Situated on a certified organic 89-acre vineyard with another 16

acres of vineyards in Eola-Amity Hills and 22 acres in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA, B Corp certified Sokol Blosser Winery consistently captures the terroir of the region as expressed through the brialliance of its estate fruit. One of the pioneering wineries of Oregon, Sokol Blosser is run by the Sokol Blosser family, who emphasize sustainability and good to the earth policies in every phase of business.

Stoller Family Estate

At Stoller our roots run deep. The family established the property in 1943 and the vineyard 50 years later. Over the last 29 years, we have patiently transformed the 400-acre property into the largest contiguous vineyard in Oregon's Dundee Hills. We control every step of the wine-growing and winemaking process, from pruning to bottling and everything in between. The result is award-winning wines that are balanced, complex, and consistently exceptional. Much has changed from the original Stoller family farm, but two things remain constant: our pioneering spirit and commitment to our farm. We continuously seek new ways to refine and protect our legacy, so that it can thrive for generations to come.

2019 Stoller Family Estate Pinot Noir: Over the last 29 years, our estate vineyard's 108 meticulously farmed sections have become more expressive, each showing something unique and distinct. Because of this, our winemaking team seized the opportunity to craft an Estate Pinot Noir from our maturing vines. Rich aromatics of ripe black raspberry, cherry compote, and black licorice fill the glass. The palate is generous, showing flavors of cherry cola, baking spice and a ferrous minerality: classic Dundee Hills.



Winter's Hill Estate

Sitting atop the storied Dundee Hills of Oregon, Winter's Hill is owned and operated by the Gladhart family. Today the third generation is developing the farm established in 1961. Together with our employees, we manage our vineyards, fields, and forests for the long-term benefit of our family and our community. The vineyards were planted in 1990, and we produce 100% estate grown and produced wines from Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris and Pinot Blanc.

2019 Winters Hill Pinot Noir Block 8: From the steepest section of our vineyard, Block 8 is planted to the Wadenswil Clone. The 2019 vintage is very fragrant and floral on the nose, with luscious red fruit such as raspberry and pie cherry. Tannins are full and spicy, with notes of anise on the finish.
