Alexana Winery

Alexana Winery was born out of vintner Dr. Madaiah Revana’s love of the great wines of Burgundy. After an extensive search for the ideal region and land, Dr. Revana acquired an 80-acre estate uniquely located on the northwestern edge of the Dundee Hills AVA where iron-rich volcanic soils converge with the ancient marine sedimentary soils of the Pacific Ocean.

2021 Revana Vineyard Estate Pinot Noir: The Alexana Estate Pinot Noir expresses the entire Estate’s dramatically diverse terroir, which includes 18 different soil types. This unique expression of Oregon Pinot Noir comes from one of the Willamette Valley’s most respected vineyards and contains notes of pine duff, acai, blueberry and spun sugar on the nose and black cherry with a dusty finish and firm tannins on the palate.



Anderson Family Vineyard

This vineyard has been our family’s mission since we found our 20-acres – an ancient pile of fractured basalt – in the Dundee Hills in 1989. And since, through years of clearing and planting, supply of superior wine grapes to several winery partners, and creation of our own hands-on small-batch bottlings, our goals have remained the same: plant on steep slopes, grow deep roots, deliver intense flavors. Enjoy!

2021 Dundee Hills Estate Pinot Noir: Classic, rich, loaded with spice and earthy minerals. Plum, cinnamon, meat and cola-tinged briar wrapped in lush layers.



Archery Summit Winery

Since its start in 1993, Archery Summit has long been committed to understanding the intricacies and unique characteristics of each of their vineyards, resulting in wines that vividly express their distinct places of origin.

2021 Arcus Vineyard Pinot Noir: The Arcus Pinot Noir is a rewarding wine to produce, made from fruit grown on some of the steepest slopes in the Dundee Hills. The nose leads with rich, dark cherries and ripe plum, followed by notes of green tea, eucalyptus and basaltic chalk. The palate is robust, showing berries, white pepper, strawberry rhubarb and a subtle, integrated stem-y note thanks to a small percentage of whole cluster fermentation. Offering tremendous length, this wine is floral and fruit-driven, speckled here and there with pleasant hints of spice.



Argyle Winery

Argyle Winery’s history is a quintessential Oregon tale, complete with the promise of staking claim to new spaces, taking risks and embracing opportunities and possibilities. Known as “Oregon’s Original Sparkling Wine House”, Argyle began in 1987, and now produces grower sparkling wine, silky Pinot Noir, barrel aged Chardonnay, and Riesling.

2021 Spirithouse Pinot Noir: Composed and harmonious – a tricky combination to achieve in winemaking, yet perfectly represented in the Spirithouse Pinot Noir. While this wine typically leans red or black fruit, this year it balances between the two, adding in the aromatics of pink flowers and pomegranates and wraps up with silky tannins and rich mouthfeel.



Ayoub Winery

Ayoub winemaking reflects a combination of tradition and innovation. Ever evolving, like the wines, Mo's winemaking approach includes experimentation with a commitment to bottling only the most successful, elegant lots among the barrels. In the winery, all wines are fermented in small lots to provide better control over the fermentation process. The goal is to produce wines that showcase the vineyard's distinct terroir, wines that have great balance and structure, silky with complex flavor profile, and age-worthy. The consistency of Ayoub wines results from a continuous learning mindset in which there is no temptation toward quantity, and every intent to thrill our loyal supporters with each vintage.

2021 Ayoub Pinot Noir: Perfumy and seductive nose with wild strawberry, red sherry, orange blossom and nutmeg. Satiny and complex on the palate, with generous bright red cherry, raspberry, savory notes and lots of tension. This wine is silky with a sophisticated focus. This is a beautiful wine, another great expression of the Estate vineyard, that needs time to reveal its full beauty. Best from 2023 to 2033. Alcohol: 13.5%, PH: 3.54, Production 350 cases.



Cramoisi Vineyards

Cramoisi, French for crimson, is derived from the delightful crimson clover that blankets the vineyard every spring. Vibrant, elegant, earthy; Cramoisi reflects the color, beauty and complexity of our boutique wines born from red volcanic soils. Organic, Biodynamic farm, Estate grown with respect for the land, the grape and hardworking vineyard stewards. Every bottle honors and delivers our passion, from soil to glass.

2021 Sofias Block Pinot Noir: 100% Dijon 667 pinot noir clones. Sofia's favorite clone from her namesake block. Delicate and elegant, velvety, earthy in the palate. Beautiful bright color and with a lingering savory finish. Will age wisely. 13% whole cluster.



De Ponte Cellars

The name De Ponte comes from the matriarch of the Baldwin family, Shirley Baldwin. De Ponte, her maiden name, which is of Portuguese origin, honors her father who grew grapes and made his own wine in California's San Joaquin Valley. De Ponte released its first Pinot Noir to critical acclaim in 2001, reflecting the dedication of the Baldwin Family and its French Winemaker Isabelle Dutartre to produce a remarkable wine. Dutartre learned the art of winemaking in her home of the Burgundy region of France and each vintage reflects her uncompromising commitment to quality and tradition.

2021 De Ponte Cellars Estate Pinot Noir: 2021 De Ponte Cellars "Estate" Pinot noir/252 cases produced/15 months in 50% new oak and 50% neutral. Beautiful garnet color in the glass. Intoxicating scents of marionberry jam, spice and dark rose petal. The wine is soft and silky on the palate with dark berry fruits and toffee accentuated with spice, and soft silky tannins.



Dobbes Family Estate

Founded in 2002, Dobbes Family Estate embodies over three decades of fine winemaking. Making wines that are true to their varietal character, showing as much depth, elegance, opulence, and balance as possible. Dobbes is dedicated to consistently crafting wines that exude the best of Oregon including traditionally made Burgundian-inspired Pinot Noir and other varietals from Oregon's Willamette and Rogue Valleys.

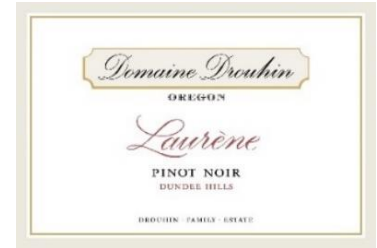
2021 Dundee Hills Cuvée Pinot Noir: COLOR: Medium Ruby, AROMA: Sandalwood, charred orange, grape jelly, incense, briar, PALATE: Very savory, with the kind of brambly rustic structure that gives great wines energy. This wine is soft with chalky tannins, and a bright acid profile. FLAVOR: Tobacco, cherry, orange pith, black cherry, bay leaf, AGING: Aged in 20% New French Oak for 12 months, PAIRINGS: Kale salad with Lemon Vinaigrette, Roasted Turkey, Baked Apple Crisp.



Domaine Drouhin Oregon

Established in 1987, Domaine Drouhin Oregon is owned by the Drouhin Family of Burgundy. Fourth-generation winemaker Véronique Boss-Drouhin produces wines of distinction, balance, elegance, and longevity. Philippe Drouhin oversees the family vineyards in Burgundy and Oregon and is responsible for the 235-acre estate.

2021 Domaine Drouhin Oregon Pinot Noir Laurène: The 2021 Pinot Noir Laurène upholds the cuvée's 30-year tradition of excellence, elegance, expressiveness, and ageability. The energetic nose reveals notes of baked Rainier cherry and candied orange peel, with subtle sage and wild herb undertones. Blueberry notes intertwine with baking spice and anise on the palate, offering a complex and layered experience. In your glass or your cellar, the 2021 Laurène is a pure reflection of vintage, place and people.



Domaine Roy & fils

Domaine Roy & Fils found its home on a site named the Iron Filbert Vineyard, paying homage to the iron rich Jory soil series and the old filbert orchard that once stood there. Planted in April of 2013 with neighboring iconic vineyards of Bergström, Cameron, and Maresh. Ten clones of Pinot Noir and two clones of chardonnay make up a high-density average of 2310 vines per acre.

2021 Domaine Roy & Fils, Incline Pinot Noir: The 2021 Dundee Hills Incline Pinot Noir opens with spirit, showing bright raspberry, blueberry, and baking spices reminiscent of holiday festivities. Supple red fruit and bright, lively acidity carry a great energy through the core of the wine. The palate is approachable yet refined, an earlier drinker that will continue to age well for 8-10 years.

Domaine Willamette

The biodynamically farmed, 25-acre Bernau Estate Vineyard in the Dundee Hills AVA produces a small lot of Pinot Noir each year (570 cases of the 2021 vintage) as well as Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier for sparkling wine. The vineyard serves as the home of Willamette Valley Vineyards' Domaine Willamette sparkling winery and is named after its winegrower founders and industry leaders, Jim and Jan Bernau.

2021 Bernau Estate Pinot Noir: The Dundee Hills single vineyard designate presents scarlet hues. Fruit notes and barrel toast intrigue the nose, moving from cherry cola to black tea and anise. Abundant aromatics of boysenberry and cherry mirror red fruit flavors on the palate. Bright flavors of the Pinot Noir grapes are offset with barrel toast of cedar and vanilla. Food pairings: Enjoy with a roasted beet salad with goat cheese, garlic pork medallions, braised chicken with morels and polenta, mushroom risotto and medium cheeses.



DOMAINE WILLAMETTE

Durant Vineyards

First and foremost, the Durant Family strives to be viticulturists whose wines reflect careful farming and craftsmanship. As a founder in the Oregon wine industry, with their first plantings in 1973, their goal is to produce wines that are of the highest quality. The 100% estate grown fruit is proudly labeled as Durant Vineyards.

2021 Olivia Grace Pinot Noir: The entrance to the 2021 Olivia Grace Pinot noir is intricate and diverse. The mid palate is full of texture and layers of fruit, spices, herbs and barrel components. The finish to the wine is perfectly framed with gorgeous acidity and integrated stem, barrel and skin tannins.



Élevée Winegrowers

Élevée Winegrowers is a "Study in Terroir" ...focused on exploring the distinct flavors of the Willamette Valley's diverse Appellations. Élevée's ultimate goal is to introduce you to the most beautiful, dramatic, and wonderfully diverse personalities of Pinot noir and Riesling from Oregon's Willamette Valley. To achieve this they have identified, and continue to identify, the most dramatic environments to grow their grapes, that promise to deliver wines with the most dramatic expressions. They carefully farm the vineyards and handle the wines in ways that capture the purest expression of each site.

2021 Élevée Vineyard Pinot Noir: This wine reveals a captivating perfume of raspberries, cherries, keemun black tea, & powdered lilacs, with hints of baking spices & cola, around a mineral core. This is a medium to full body wine, with lively acidity, & broad, fine, silky texture. The long finish lingers with a chorus of raspberries, fading violet petals, & Dundee dust.



Erath Winery

Erath wines are an expression of the land that this winery has cultivated for over 50 years. Disciplined in approach, yet progressive in artistry, our winemaker strives to create wines that reflect the prestige of the region and honor the rich history of the brand.

2021 Knights Gambit Pinot Noir: This wine encapsulates everything we love about the Dundee Hills – unabashed red cherry and currant flavors, generous palate weight and silky texture, and a seamless almost-too-drinkable finish. Complex notes of thyme, nutmeg, and cocoa add to the loveliness and length of this wine.



Holloran Vineyard Wines

Small production, sustainably farmed wines that represent the unique characteristics of our vineyards. As a grower and wine producer since 1999 in Oregon's Willamette Valley, their handcrafted wines begin in the vineyards they own and farm. They emphasize low yields and careful hands-on management of the vines to produce wines that express the unique characteristics of the vineyard sites, including their older vines planted in the early 1970s.

2021 Holloran Pinot Noir Dundee Hills: Spicy red cherry with cinnamon greets the nose, with earthy notes typical of Jory based sites in the Dundee Hills. The palate is elegant and shows dusty cherry notes. The finish is quite focused and persistent and includes plenty of crisp acidity. Enjoy this lovely wine with Roasted Chicken with Tarragon Jus. Drink 2024 – 2032, decanting recommended in early years.



Knudsen Vineyards

Knudsen Vineyards is an iconic vineyard in the heart of the acclaimed Dundee Hills AVA overlooking the fertile Willamette Valley, majestic Mt. Hood and the North Cascade Mountain range. The Knudsen family has grown grapes and made wine for 50 years. Knudsen Vineyards was established in 1971 by Cal and Julia Lee Knudsen. As second-generation stewards of Knudsen Vineyards, Page, Colin, David and Cal Jr embrace their family's legacy and honor their parents by making great wine reflecting the unique attributes of their land.

2021 Family Series Pinot Noir: This youthful Pinot noir is an estate blend showcasing the overall style of the 2021 vintage. A warm growing season provided lovely robust fruit and spice as well as savory notes to aid in long-term aging. Aromas of red cherry, chocolate, cherry cola and clove open up in the glass and grace the palate with structured flavors of blackberry, tobacco, black pepper and blackcurrant. The supple tannins and gripping acidity offer a complex and long finish with subtle hints of violet and toast. Drink now after 1-2 hours of decanting, or age for 7-10 years.

Lange Estate Winery

Don and Wendy Lange founded their eponymous winery and estate vineyard in 1987 with the purchase of a thirty-acre parcel in Northern Willamette Valley's prestigious Dundee Hills. Their move north from Santa Barbara was precipitated by a few inspiring bottles from two of Oregon's most iconic producers: Eyrie and Erath. A call to Dick Erath (whose phone number was listed on the back label) convinced the Langes to embark on a scouting trip. Starting at the southern end of the Willamette Valley, they tasted their way up, stopping only when they reached the Dundee Hills. The couple saw a real estate sign advertising a property suitable for farmland—the property's elevation and aspect reminded Don of the Grand Cru vineyards of Burgundy's Côte d'Or. The Langes planted their estate vineyard in 1988.

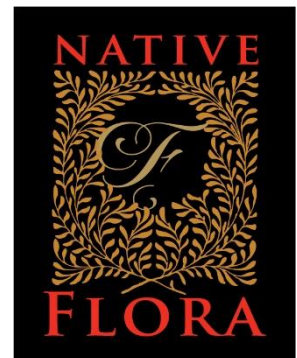
LANGE ESTATE

2021 Lange Estate Vineyards Pinot Noir: Our 2021 Estate Pinot Noir displays an exuberant nose of strawberry and black raspberry interlaced with lavender, crushed stone, cardamom, and bergamot. It's a seamless wine, with gathering energy on the palate that gives rise to a core of blue and black fruit along with a lively flourish of minerality and sweet tobacco on the finish.

Native Flora

Native Flora, the Dundee Hills Winery Sanctum, is a small, secluded vineyard and winery hidden high above the Chehalem Valley. With stunning vistas, innovative ideas, and a rebel spirit, they produce premium estate wines in limited quantities for folks who appreciate great bottles. The earth, the vineyard, the people, the flora and fauna, the buildings, the rain – everything that exists on our 33-acre site – work in harmony to grow great grapes and produce fine wine.

2021 Jaguar Reserve Pinot Noir: Jaguar represents the pinnacle of the Native Flora Pinot production. A clonal-driven barrel selection, anchored by 828 and Wadenswil, this pinot shows great depth, power and structure. When we first personified this wine with the name *Jaguar*, it was to describe a dark, stealthy, muscular kitty of a wine. It has become a very apt analogy for describing the wine on a year-to-year basis. The 2021 Jaguar has the silkiest, lustrous black coat you've ever seen. The best analogy for this Jaguar is the alpha male of a lion pride. He is the king of beasts (Jaguars in this case) with flowing mane, regal countenance - let the lionesses hunt for him - he is going to sit on his throne and simply look stellar. Aromatics lean towards rose petal, and cherry liquor - almost a Kirschwasser. The palate is dense velvet cerise, with great viscosity and structure. The tannins are super plentiful but never clunky - the finish coats your mouth in powdered sugar-like texture. Cellar up to 15+ years.



Nysa Vineyard

Nysa Vineyard is a family-owned operation founded in 1990. Owner and winemaker, Michael Mega purchased a parcel of orchards high in the Dundee Hills of Oregon in anticipation of growing world-class pinot. It was with passion, hard work and patience that Nysa Vineyard has become one of the most prestigious in the hills, providing Pinot noir to acclaimed producers throughout the Willamette Valley.

2021 Nysa Estate Pinot Noir: The wine begins with rich aromas of black fruits, smoke and Bing cherry. In the mouth those fruits are supported by a broad streak of roasted espresso beans, along with well-balanced notes of earth, herb and leaf. A hint of baking spice sneaks through the finish.

Résonance

As stewards of our Oregon estate vineyards and winery, the Résonance team shares close, personal relationships going back more than 50 years. When a world-class wine lets us discover the soul of a place, something magical happens. A deeply emotional and physical connection to its land, its people, its culture, and its history. 2021 Découverte Vineyard Pinot Noir: This wine has a bright color and elegant fragrance of wild strawberry, raspberry, rose, lavender, licorice, nutmeg and noble wood. The palate is especially delicate and supple, with expressive fruity and floral aromas, balanced by a volcanic energy.

Sokol Blosser

For nearly 50 years, before there was an Oregon wine industry, the Sokol Blosser family began growing grapes in the Dundee Hills of Oregon's Willamette Valley. Situated on a certified organic 89-acre vineyard with another 16 acres of vineyards in Eola-Amity Hills and 22 acres in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA, B Corp certified Sokol Blosser Winery consistently captures the terroir of the region as expressed through the brilliance of its estate fruit. One of the pioneering wineries of Oregon, Sokol Blosser is run by the Sokol Blosser family, who emphasize sustainability and good to the earth policies in every phase of business.

2021 Big Tree Block Estate Pinot Noir: Our 2021 Big Tree Block Pinot Noir has fresh pomegranate, dark cherry, and a slight floral presence on the nose. On the palate, pomegranate and dark cherry continue with rhubarb coming to the forefront followed by a lovely long finish.

Stoller Family Estate

At Stoller our roots run deep. The family established the property in 1943 and the vineyard 50 years later. Over the last 29 years, we have patiently transformed the 400-acre property into the largest contiguous vineyard in Oregon's Dundee Hills. We control every step of the wine-growing and winemaking process, from pruning to bottling and everything in between. The result is award-winning wines that are balanced, complex, and consistently exceptional. Much has changed from the original Stoller family farm, but two things remain constant: our pioneering spirit and commitment to our farm. We continuously seek new ways to refine and protect our legacy, so that it can thrive for generations to come.

2021 Stoller Family Estate Pinot Noir: This wine highlights how well this site can balance ripeness and acidity, even in the warmest of vintages. It opens with a tangle of red and blue fruits, showcasing beautiful notes of dark cranberry and dried cherry. The palate is dense with pomegranate and spiced berry that is then supported by a rich silky tannin. The finish of the wine lifts and then tapers elegantly into flavors of baking spice and blueberry crumble. Drink now through 2035.

Winderlea

In 2006, Donna Morris and Bill Sweat relocated from Boston and made Dundee, Oregon their home. Second careers and naivety in pursuit of their shared passion to grow grapes and make wine describes their lives in Oregon. The kernels of Winderlea were spun over milestone birthdays and anniversaries, travels to favorite wine regions, and nightly dinners with a bottle of wine after good and not so good days at the office. Today Donna and Bill are committed to the traditions of responsible stewardship of the land and the highest quality artisan winemaking that started here in the 60s.

2021 Winderlea Vineyard Pinot Noir: 2021 Winderlea Vineyard Pinot noir, Broad and energized, this wine sends flavors of mulled rhubarb, strawberry jam, red peony and cherries jubilee swirling from the glass. Huckleberry and lightly toasted pine nut comes through with herbaceous notes of tarragon and fennel on its heels. The palate has weight yet is backed by a nervy acidity, leading to an elongated finish.



Winter's Hill Estate

Sitting atop the storied Dundee Hills of Oregon, Winter's Hill is owned and operated by the Gladhart family. Today the third generation is developing the farm established in 1961. Together with our employees, we manage our vineyards, fields, and forests for the long-term benefit of our family and our community. The vineyards were planted in 1990, and we produce 100% estate grown and produced wines from Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris and Pinot Blanc.

2021 Winters Hill Pinot Noir Block 10: Pommard clone Pinot Noir. Deep Boysenberry color. Nose with tangerine and white flower blossoms. Fresh ripe berries build a plush mid-palate. Finishes with plump, juicy acidity. Very approachable now.



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
